Vital statistics in June 2016

- The number of births increased and the number of deaths decreased in June 2016 compared to May 2016.
- The number of marriages was higher and the number of divorces was lower in June 2016 than in May 2016.
- The number of deaths of children under 1 year rose in June 2016 compared to May 2016.

June 2016 compared to May 2016


Birth rate, death rate and natural increase¹


The births of 15230 children were recorded in June 2016, 738 more than in May 2016.

The number of persons whose **deaths** were recorded in June 2016 was 20812, 199 less than in May 2016.

The **natural increase** in June 2016 was negative (5582 persons, an excess of deceased persons over live births).

The number of **deaths of children under 1 year** recorded in June 2016 was 127, an increase of 3 compared to May 2016 (124 deceased persons under 1 year).







Marriage rate and divorce rate²

13625 marriages were recorded at Register Offices in June 2016, 1118 more than in May 2016.

2452 **divorces** were formally pronounced by final court decree and in accordance with Law No 202/2010, 266 less than in May 2016.

June 2016 compared to June 2015

Birth rate, death rate and natural increase³

The number of **live births** fell by 1003 in June 2016 compared to the same month of 2015, and the number of persons who **died** was higher by 1409 than in June 2015. The **natural increase** was negative both in June 2016 (5582 persons) and in June 2015 (3170 persons).

The number of **children under 1 year who died** in June 2016 was higher by 9 than the one recorded in June 2015.

Marriage rate and divorce rate⁴

The number of marriages increased by 3897 in June 2016 compared to the same month of the previous year. In June 2016, 460 less divorces than in June 2015 were formally pronounced by final court decree and in accordance with Law No 202/2010.
