THE EXPENDITURES WITH THE SOCIAL PROTECTION ARE 5.4% MORE COMPARED TO 2014

In 2015:

- the receipts of social protection amounted to 106347 million lei, 6.7% more compared to the previous year. The weight in the Gross Domestic Product (GDP semi-final data) was of 14.9%, being at the same level as the previous year;
- the expenditures with the social protection (the administrative costs of the social protection schemes included) amounted to 103883 million lei, around 5.4% more compared to the previous year. The weight of this category of expenditure in the GDP was of 14.6%, less 0.2 pp compared to 2014;
- the expenditures with the social benefits (the administrative costs and other expenditure excluded) were 14.3% of the GDP, 0.2 pp less compared to 2014.

The same as during the previous years (2005-2014), the social protection was mainly oriented to cover the risks of old age and of sickness or health care which meant 50.5% and 26.6%, respectively, of the total expenditure with the social benefits.
