## THE EXPENDITURES WITH THE SOCIAL PROTECTION INCREASED BY 10.2% COMPARED TO 2016

In 2017:

- **the receipts of social protection** amounted to 130363 million lei, 12.3% more compared to the previous year. The share in the Gross Domestic Product (GDP – semi-final data) was 15.2%, same percentage as in previous year;
- **the expenditures with the social protection** (the administrative costs of the social protection schemes included) amounted to 123181 million lei, i.e. an increase of 10.2% compared to the previous year. The share of this category of expenditures in the GDP was 14.4%, a decrease of 0.3 pp compared to 2016;
- **the expenditures with the social benefits** (the administrative costs and other expenditures excluded) were 14.1% of the GDP, 0.3 pp decreased compared to 2016.

As in previous years (2007-2016), the social protection was mainly oriented to cover the risks of old age and of sickness or health care, i.e. 51.8% and 27.9% of the total expenditures with the social benefits.
