Subdomain: Animal production

In 2015, compared to 2014, the total milk production decreased by 2.7%.

- Compared to the previous year, in 2015 the weight of the animals to be slaughtered for consumption increased for all species.
- Compared to the previous year, in 2015 the production of milk and eggs decreased and the wool production increased.

In 2015, compared to 2014, the following facts were recorded:

- the weight of the animals and poultry to be slaughtered for consumption increased by 8.8% per total, with 14.3% for poultry, 9.3% for cattle, 5.0% for pigs and 1.9% for sheep and goats;
- the total milk production was 2.7% lower;
- the wool production increased by 2.4%;
- the total egg production decreased by 1.2%.

Chart 1: Structure of total meat production (live weight), in 2015



In 2015, compared to 2014, the meat production structure registered the following phenomena: the share of poultry production increased (+1.9 percentage points), the share of beef production increased (+0.1 pp), the share of pork production decreased (-1.5 pp) and the share of mutton, lamb and goat meat decreased (-0.5 pp).

Chart 2: Cow milk production in 2015, by development regions



In 2015 the cow milk production (including calves' consumption) was of 42402 thousand hectolitres, with 1311 thousand hectolitres (-3.0%) less than in the previous year. Drops were registered in the following development regions: Centre (-6.5%), West (-3.7%), South Muntenia (-2.9%), South West-Oltenia (-2.6%), South-East and North-East (-2.5%), North-West (-0.8%) and in the Bucharest-Ilfov development region the production remained constant.
