Environmental protection expenditure in 2021

- In 2021, the environmental protection expedniture at national level amounted to approximately 16.9 billion lei¹⁾, accounting for about 1.4% of the GDP²⁾.
- At national level, the highest environmental protection expenditure was recorded in the waste management domain, for the specialised producers, with a share of 77.3% of the total waste management related expenditure.
- At national level, the highest environmental protection investments were recorded for the wastewater management by general government, with a share of 74.8% of the total investments in wastewater management.


In 2021, at national level, the environmental protection investments accounted for approximately 24.4% of the total environmental protection expenditure.


At national level, the investments of general government had the highest share in the total environmental protection investments (52.4%), followed by the investments of unspecialised producers (26.7%) and by those of specialised producers (20.9%). The unspecialised producers reported the highest environmental protection expenditure in the field of "electric and thermal energy, gas and hot water production and supply" (49.3%), in the field of "manufacturing" (15.9%) and in the field of "water collection, treatment and supply" (14.1%).

¹⁾ The expenditure at national level includes: investments, the current internal expenditure (current expenditure on own environmental protection activities) and other expenditure of general government (subsidies granted, transfers), while the current external expenditure (mainly consisting of the expenditure on the purchase of environmental protection services from third parties) is not included.

²⁾ GDP – 2021 provisional data

In 2021, the biggest environmental protection investments were recorded for wastewater management, with a value of 2,274,294 thousand lei current prices.





In 2021, the highest environmental protection expenses were reported for the waste management domain, with a value of 9,059,787 thousand lei current prices, followed by the wastewater management domain, with 3,427,437 thousand lei current prices.

The largest environmental protection expenditure was recorded by specialised producers for the domain of "waste management", with 93.1% of the expenses of this category of producers, accounting for 77.3% of the national-level environmental protection expenditure in this environmental domain. This is followed by the expenses of this category of producers, accounting for 53.3% of the national-level environmental protection expenditure in this environmental domain.
