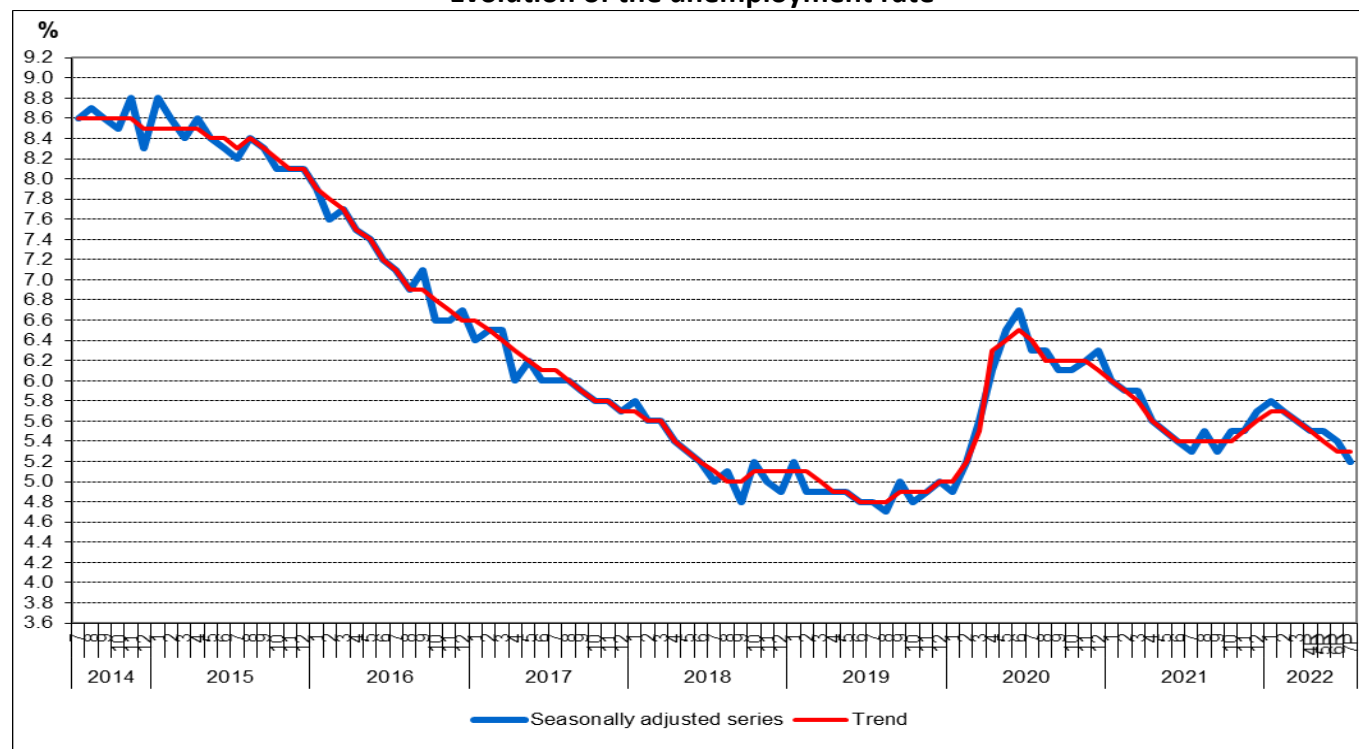


Area: ILO\* unemployment

## In July 2022, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was estimated at 5.2%

- Unemployment rate\*\* in July 2022 decreased with 0.2 percentage points as compared to June 2022 (5.4%).
- Men's unemployment rate was higher than that of women with 1.5 percentage points.

Evolution of the unemployment rate



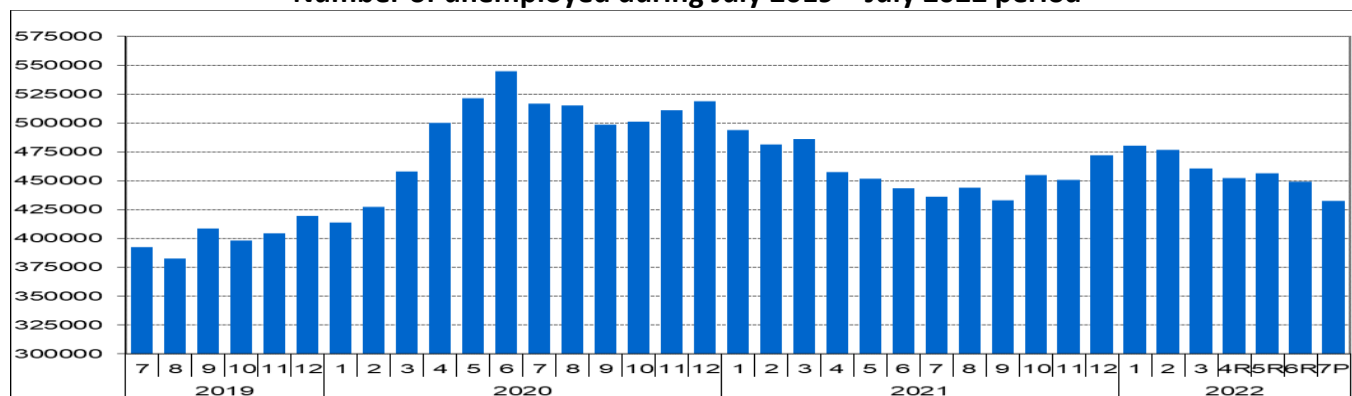

The number of unemployed (aged 15-74 years) estimated for July 2022 was of 432,7 thousand persons, decreasing as compared to the previous month (449,0 thousand persons), as well as compared to July 2021 (436,1 thousand persons).

According to the breakdown by gender, men's unemployment rate was with 1.5 percentage points higher than that of women (the values concerned are 5.8% for men and 4.3% for women).

The high level of the unemployment rate among young people (15-24 years old) of 22.8% still holds attention.

The unemployment rate of adult persons (aged 25-74 years) was estimated at 4.1% for July 2022 (3.3% in the case of women and 4.7% in that of men's).

The number of unemployed aged 25-74 years accounted for 73.9% of the total number of unemployed estimated for July 2022.

\*\* The **unemployment rate** is the weight of the unemployed in the active population.
