Area: Employment and unemployment

In the first quarter of 2016, the employment rate for working age population (15-64 years) was 59.8%, decreasing as against the one recorded during previous quarter

- In the first quarter of 2016, the employment rate for population aged 20-64 years was 64.5%, at a distance of 5.5 percentage points of the national target of 70% established in the context of the Strategy Europe 2020.
- In the first quarter of 2016, the economically active population of Romania was 8834 thousand persons, out of which 8249 thousand employed persons and 585 thousand unemployed persons.

In the first quarter of 2016, the employment rate for working age population (15-64 years) was 59.8%, decreasing as against the one recorded during previous quarter by 1.6 percentage points. The employment rate was higher for men (67.2% as against 52.2% for women) and for persons from urban area (61.2% as compared to 58.0% in rural area).

The employment rate for youth (15-24 years) was 20.4%.

Evolution of employment rate for population aged 15 years and over, by age groups



Unemployment rate in the first quarter of 2016 was 6.6%, the same value as the one recorded for the previous quarter.

Unemployment rate by age groups, sex and area, in the first quarter of 2016



By sex, the gap between the two unemployment rates was 2.3 percentage points (7.6% for men as against 5.3% for women), while by residential area it was only 0.2 percentage points (6.7% for urban area, as against 6.5% for rural area).

The unemployment rate reached the highest level (21.8%) among young persons (15-24 years).
