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
Area: Employment and unemployment

# In the first quarter of 2017, the employment rate for the working age population (15-64 years) was 61.2%, decreasing as against the one recorded during the previous quarter

- In the first quarter of 2017, the employment rate for the population aged 20-64 years was 66.2%, at a distance of 3.8 percentage points of the national target of 70% established in the context of the Strategy Europe 2020.
- In the first quarter of 2017, the economically active population of Romania was 8804 thousand persons, out of which 8323 thousand were employed persons and 481 thousand unemployed persons.

- thou. persons -





In the first quarter of 2017, the employment rate for the working age population (15-64 years) was 61.2%, decreasing as against the one recorded during the previous quarter by 0.4 percentage points. The employment rate was higher for men (68.9% as against 53.5% for women) and for residents in the urban area (63.7% as against 58.1% in rural area).

The employment rate for youth (15-24 years) was 21.4%.


## Evolution of employment rate for population aged 15 years and over, by age groups

Unemployment rate in the first quarter of 2017 was 5.5%, the same value as the one recorded for the previous quarter.

By sex, the gap between the two unemployment rates was 1.9 percentage points (6.3% for men as against 4.4% for women), while by residential areas it was 1.7 percentage points (6.4% for rural area, as against 4.7% for urban area).

The unemployment rate reached the highest level (20.4%) among young persons (15-24 years).
