
**Area: Employment and unemployment** 

# In the second quarter of 2015, the employment rate for working age population (15-64 years) was 62.0%, increasing as against the one recorded during previous quarter

- In the second quarter of 2015, the employment rate for population aged 20-64 years was 66.6%, at a distance of 3.4 percentage points of the national target of 70% established in the context of the Strategy Europe 2020.
- In the second quarter of 2015, the economically active population of Romania was 9289 thousand persons, out of which 8664 thousand employed persons and 625 thousand unemployed persons.

- thou. persons -





In the second quarter of 2015, the employment rate for working age population (15-64 years) was 62.0%, increasing as against the one recorded during previous quarter (2.9 percentage points). The employment degree was higher for men (70.0% as against 53.9% for women) and for residents from rural area (63.4% as against 60.9% in urban area).

The employment rate for youth (15-24 years) was 24.8%.

# Evolution of employment rate for population aged 15 years and over, by age groups



Unemployment rate in the second quarter of 2015 was 6.7%, decreasing as compared to the previous quarter (7.4%).

## Unemployment rate by age groups, sex and area, in the second quarter of 2015



### Chart data (xls)

By sex, the gap between the two unemployment rates was 2.0 percentage points (7.6% for men as against 5.6% for women), while by residential area it was 1.0 percentage points (7.2% for urban area, as against 6.2% for rural area).

The unemployment rate reached the highest level (20.4%) among young persons (15-24 years).
