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
Area: Employment and unemployment

# In the third quarter of 2016, the employment rate for the working age population (15-64 years) was 63.1%, increasing as against the one recorded during the previous quarter

- In the third quarter of 2016, the employment rate for the population aged 20-64 years was 67.7%, at a distance of 2.3 percentage points of the national target of 70% established in the context of the Strategy Europe 2020.
- In the third quarter of 2016, the economically active population of Romania was 9144 thousand persons, out of which 8625 thousand were employed persons and 519 thousand unemployed persons.

- thou. persons -





In the third quarter of 2016, the employment rate for the working age population (15-64 years) was 63.1%, increasing as against the one recorded during the previous quarter by 1.3 percentage points. The employment rate was higher for men (71.7% as against 54.4% for women) and for residents in the urban area (63.7% as against 62.3% in rural area).

The employment rate for youth (15-24 years) was 24.9%.


### Evolution of employment rate for population aged 15 years and over, by age groups

Unemployment rate in the third quarter of 2016 was 5.7%, decreasing as compared to the previous quarter (5.9%).

By sex, the gap between the two unemployment rates was 1.4 percentage points (6.3% for men as against 4.9% for women), while by residential areas it was 1.3 percentage points (6.4% for rural area, as against 5.1% for urban area).

The unemployment rate reached the highest level (20.5%) among young persons (15-24 years).
