

Area: Employment and unemployment

In the fourth quarter of 2015, the employment rate for working age population (15-64 years) was 61.4%, decreasing as against the one recorded during previous quarter.

- In the fourth quarter of 2015, the employment rate for population aged 20-64 years was 66.1%, at a distance of 3.9 percentage points of the national target of 70% established in the context of the Strategy Europe 2020.
- In the fourth quarter of 2015, the economically active population of Romania was 9085 thousand persons, out of which 8483 thousand were employed persons and 602 thousand were unemployed persons.

Population categories in the fourth quarter of 2015





In the fourth quarter of 2015, the employment rate for working age population (15-64 years) was 61.4%, decreasing as against the one recorded during previous quarter (1.8 percentage points). The employment degree was higher for men (69.7% as against 52.9% for women) and for residents from urban area (62.2% as against 60.4% in rural area).

The employment rate for youth (15-24 years) was 23.5%.

Unemployment rate in the fourth quarter of 2015 was 6.6%, easy increasing as compared to the previous quarter (6.5%).

Unemployment rate by age groups, sex and area, in the fourth quarter of 2015



By sex, the gap between the two unemployment rates was 1.3 percentage points (7.2% for men as against 5.9% for women), while by residential area it was 0.3 percentage points (6.5% for urban area, as against 6.8% for rural area).

The unemployment rate reached the highest level (21.8%) among young persons (15-24 years).
