
Area: Employment and unemployment

## In the fourth quarter of 2017, the employment rate for the working age population (15-64 years) was 63.4%, decreasing as against the one recorded during the previous quarter

- In the fourth quarter of 2017, the employment rate\* for the population aged 20-64 years was 68.4%, at a distance of 1.6 percentage points of the national target of 70% established in the context of the Strategy Europe 2020.
- In the fourth quarter of 2017, the economically active population of Romania was 8966 thousand persons, out of which 8541 thousand were employed persons and 425 thousand unemployed persons.

- thou. persons -





In the fourth quarter of 2017, the employment rate for the working age population (15-64 years) was 63.4%, down with 1.9 percentage points from the previous quarter. The employment rate was higher for men (71.8% as against 54.8% for women) and for residents in the urban area (65.0% as against 61.5% in rural area).

The employment rate for youth (15-24 years) was 22.9%.


#### Evolution of employment rate for population aged 15 years and over, by age groups

Unemployment rate\*\* in the fourth quarter of 2017 was 4.7%, the same value as the one recorded for the previous quarter.

By sex, the gap between the two unemployment rates was 0.9 percentage points (5.1% for men as against 4.2% for women), while by residential areas it also was 0.9 percentage points (5.2% for rural area, as against 4.3% for urban area).

By age groups, the unemployment rate reached the highest level (21.2%) among young persons (15-24 years).
