Sub-domain: Area under vines for wine grapes

In 2015, the total area under vines for wine grapes was approximately 183 700 ha

- *The area under vines for noble wine grapes in 2015 accounted for 54.2% of the total area under vines.*
- *The South-East development region accounted for 41.5% of the total area under vines.*
- The area under grapes for wines with a protected designation of origin represented 32.9% of the area under vines for noble wine grapes and 17.8% of the total area under vines.
- The area under grapes for wines with a geographical indication represented 18.3% of the area under vines for noble wine grapes and 9.9% of the total area under vines.

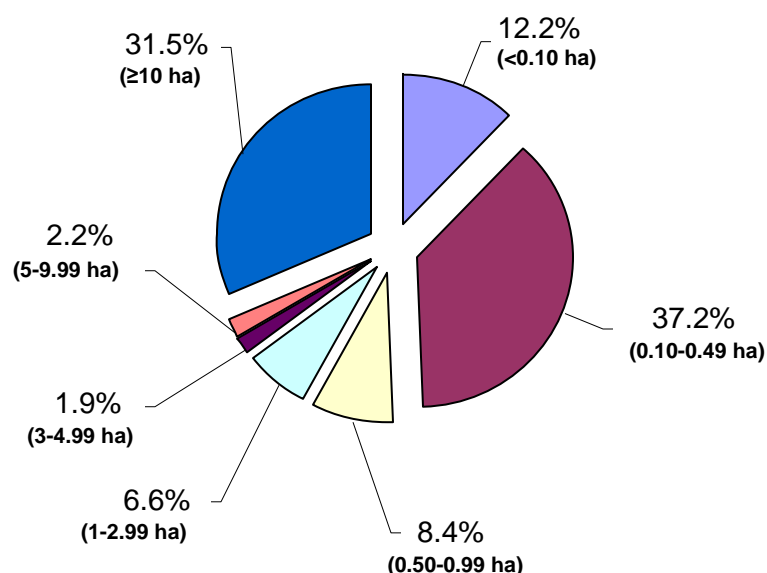
The highest share in the total area under vines for wine grapes is that of the South-East development region (41.5%), followed by the South-West Oltenia (16.6%), South-Muntenia (15.7%), North-East (15.2%), North-West (4.1%), Centre (3.5%) and West (3.2%) regions.

The highest share in the area under vines for noble wine grapes is that of the South-East development region (55.1%), followed by the North-East (12.6%), South-West Oltenia (9.7%), South-Muntenia (9.0%), West (5.5%), Centre (5.5%) and North-West (2.6%) regions.

The highest share in the area under grapes for wines with a protected designation of origin is that of the South-East development region (41.2%), followed by the North-East (15.4%), Centre (11.4%), South-Muntenia (10.8%), West (10.7%), South-West Oltenia (9.3%) and North-West (1.2%) regions.

The highest share in the area under grapes for wines with a geographical indication is that of the South-East development region (82.1%), followed by the South-Muntenia (5.7%), North-East (4.4%), North-West (3.9%), South-West Oltenia (3.4%) and West (0.5%) regions.

The highest shares in the area under vines for wine grapes are those of the 0.10-0.49 ha (37.2%) and ≥10 ha (31.5%) size classes.
