The balance indicator indicates the perception of companies' manager over the dynamics of a phenomenon, which should NOT be seen as the intensity of increase or decrease in the statistical indicator value.

Manufacturing

According to the business tendency survey of March 2016, managers from manufacturing forecast a moderate growth of the production volume (balance +15%) for the next three months. Significant increases are expected in the manufacture of beverages (balance +47%) and in the manufacture of basic pharmaceuticals and pharmaceutical preparations (balance +41%). A decrease in manufacture of basic metals is forecast (balance -18%).

For the prices of the industrial products a relative stability is forecast for the next three months (balance +1%).

Regarding the number of employees, a relative stability is forecast, the balance being 2% per total manufacturing.

Construction

According to March 2016 estimations, there will be an increase in the production volume of the construction activity for the next three months (balance +27%) and in the stock of contracts and orders (balance +21%).

Managers forecast a moderate increase in the number of employees (balance +9%).

As to the prices of construction works, a relative stability is forecast (balance 3%).

Retail trade

In the retail trade sector, managers estimate a growth tendency in the economic activity (balance +39%) for the next three months.

Employers forecast, for the next three months, a moderate increase in the number of employees (balance +6%). There will be an increase in the volume of orders placed by the trade units to the suppliers of goods (balance +30%).

For the next three months, the managers of trade companies estimate an increase of retail selling prices (balance +26%).

Services

According to March 2016 estimations, the demand of services (turnover) will have a moderate growth in the next three months (balance +14%).

In the services sector, a relative stability in the number of employees is forecast (balance +5%).

According to the managers' opinion, the selling or invoice prices of provisions will have a trend of relative stability (balance +0%).
