
The tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception increased by 6.8% in March 2016

- Compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, both the arrivals and the overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation increased by 11.1 % and by 6.8 %, respectively, in March 2016.
- Compared to March 2015, in March 2016, customs registered an increase in both the arrivals of foreign visitors of 16.1 % and in the departures abroad of the Romanian visitors of 18.7 %.



In March 2016, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 645.8 thousand, 11.1% more compared to March 2015.

In March 2016, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 75.1% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 24.9 %, weights similar to those of March 2015.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (75.4% of the total of foreign tourists) and 85.6% of them came from European Union Member States.

In March 2016, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 1236.5 thousand, 6.8% more compared to March 2015.

In March 2016, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 74.7% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 25.3%. As to the overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (74.7% of the total of foreign tourists) and 84.4% of them came from European Union Member States.

In March 2016, the average time of stay was 1.9 days for both the Romanian tourists and the foreign tourists.

In March 2016, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 21.1 % on total tourists' accommodation, 0.5 pp more compared to March 2015.

In March 2016, hotels (27.4%), hostels (16.0%), tourist boarding houses (14.3%), tourist villas (12.6%), motels (12.3%) and agro-tourist boarding houses (9.5%) registered higher indices of accommodation places.

In March 2016, the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania, according to *customs*, amounted to 701.5 thousand, 16.1% more compared to March 2015. Most of the foreign visitors came from European countries (94.2%). 58.5% of the total arrivals of the foreign visitors to Romania were from European Union Member States, out of which the most arrivals were from Hungary (32.4%), Bulgaria (28.0%), Italy and Germany (7.6% each), Poland (4.2%) and France (2.9%).

In March 2016, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad,** according to *customs*, amounted to 1118.5 thousand, 18.7% more compared to March 2015. The Romanian visitors abroad mostly used the means of road transport, 68.7 % of the total departures.

In the period 1.01-31.03.2016, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 1857.8 thousand, 15.5% more compared to the period 1.01-31.03.2015.

In the period 1.01-31.03.2016, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 77.7% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 22.3%, weights similar to those of the period 1.01-31.03.2015.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (76.0% of the total of foreign tourists) and 82.6% of them came from European Union Member States.

In the period 1.01-31.03.2016, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 3629.4 thousand, 12.9 % more compared to the period 1.01-31.03.2015.

In the period 1.01-31.03.2016, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 77.0% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 23.0%. As to the overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (74.4% of the total of foreign tourists) and 79.1% of them came from European Union Member States.

In the period 1.01-31.03.2016, **the average time of stay** was 1.9 days for the Romanian tourists and 2.0 days for the foreign tourists.

In the period 1.01-31.03.2016, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 21.2 % on total tourists' accommodation, 1.2 pp more compared to the period 1.01-31.03.2015.

In the period 1.01-31.03.2016, hotels (26.9%), hostels (15.6%), tourist boarding houses (14.9%) and tourist villas (14.8%) registered higher indices of accommodation places.

The most arrivals of foreign tourists accommodated in the establishments of tourists' reception^{*)} were from Italy (48.5 thousand), Germany (42.2 thousand), Israel (39.3 thousand), The United Kingdom (26.4 thousand) and France (26.3 thousand).

In the period 1.01-31.03.2016, **the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania**, according to *customs*, amounted to 1794.5 thousand, 9.3% more compared to the period 1.01-31.03.2015. Most of the foreign visitors came from European countries (94.2%). 55.6% of the total arrivals of the foreign visitors to Romania were from European Union Member States, out of which the most arrivals were from Hungary (30.1%), Bulgaria (29.0%), Italy (8.3%), Germany (7.0%), Poland (4.8%) and France (3.5%).

In the period 1.01-31.03.2016, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad,** according to *customs*, amounted to 3263.9 thousand, 16.0% more compared to the period 1.01-31.03.2015. The Romanian visitors abroad mostly used the means of road transport, 68.4% of the total departures.
