The tourism in May 2020

- Compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, the arrivals in the establishments
 of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation decreased by 96.9 %, while the
 overnight stays decreased by 97.0% in May 2020.
- Compared to May 2019, in May 2020 customs registered a decrease in the arrivals of foreign visitors of 81.5% and a decrease of 83.9% in the departures abroad of the Romanian visitors.







In May 2020, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 34.6 thousands, 96.9% less compared to May 2019.

In May 2020, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 96.2% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 3.8%.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (76.9% of the total of foreign tourists) and most of them came from European Union Member States.

In May 2020, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 65.7 thousands, 97.0% less compared to May 2019.

In May 2020, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 93.9% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 6.1%. As to the overnight stays of foreign citizens in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (55.0% of the total of foreign tourists) and 59.1% of them came from European Union Member States.

In May 2020, the average duration of stay was 1.9 days for Romanian tourists and 3.0 days for foreign tourists.

In May 2020, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 6.9% on total tourists' accommodation structures, decreasing by 23.4 percentage points compared to May 2019.

In May 2020, motels (10.4%), tourist villas and tourist chalets (both with 9.0% each), tourist boarding houses (8.5%), bungalows (7.5%), hostels (7.2%), and hotels (6.7%) registered higher use indices of accommodation places.

In May 2020, the arrivals of foreign visitors in Romania, according to *customs*, amounted to 196.1 thousands, 81.5% less compared to May 2019. Road and naval transport means were mostly used in case of arrivals from abroad, accounting for 94.3%, respectively for 3.7% of total arrivals.

In May 2020, the departures of Romanian visitors abroad, according to *customs*, amounted to 302.0 thousands, by 83.9% less compared to May 2019. The Romanian visitors mostly used the means of road and air transport for their departures abroad, accounting for 88.8%, respectively for 10.3% of total departures.

In the period 1.01-31.05.2020, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 1814.2 thousands, 57.9% less compared to the period 1.01-31.05.2019.

In the period 1.01-31.05.2020, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 84.3% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 15.7%.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (74.2% of the total of foreign tourists) and 71.7% of them came from European Union Member States.

In the period 1.01-31.05.2020, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 3574.7 thousands, 57.5% less compared to the period 1.01-31.05.2019.

In the period 1.01-31.05.2020, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 82.7% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 17.3%.

As to the overnight stays of foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (72.5% of the total of foreign tourists) and 70.3% of them came from European Union Member States.

In the period 1.01-31.05.2020, **the average duration of stay** was 1.9 days for Romanian tourists and 2.2 days for foreign tourists.

In the period 1.01-31.05.2020, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 21.1% on total tourists' accommodation structures, 5.4 percentage points less compared to the period 1.01-31.05.2019.

In the period 1.01-31.05.2020, hotels (25.6%), tourist villas (17.7%), hostels (17.5%), bungalows (16.3%) and tourist boarding houses (16.1%) and registered higher use indices of accommodation places.

By county ¹⁾, the number of tourists' arrivals in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation^{*)} recorded in the period 1.01 – 31.05.2020 higher values in Bucharest Municipality (302.0 thousands), Braşov (250.1 thousands), Prahova (101.2 thousands), Cluj (89.4 thousands), Mureş (80.8 thousands), Bihor (79.6 thousands), Sibiu (70.2 thousands) and Suceava (69.9 thousands), while the number of tourists' overnight stays^{*)} recorded higher values in Bucharest Municipality (544.5 thousands), Braşov (514.3 thousands), Prahova (222.9 thousands), Bihor (167.4 thousands), Vâlcea (165.2 thousands), Cluj (164.6 thousands), Mureş (157.6 thousands), Timiş (148.0 thousands) and Suceava (144.8 thousands).

Most of the foreign tourists accommodated in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation¹⁾ came from Germany (29.6 thousands), Israel (27.1 thousands), Italy (25.9 thousands), United Kingdom (17.9%) and France (16.4 thousands),

In the reference period 1.01-31.05.2020, **the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania**, according to *customs*, amounted to 2315.4 thousands, 45.3% less compared to the period 1.01-31.05.2019. The road and air means of transport were mostly used for the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania, accounting for 79.1%, respectively for 18.3% of total arrivals.

In the period 1.01-31.05.2020, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad,** according to *customs*, amounted to 4467.8 thousands, by 44.9% less compared to the period 1.01-31.05.2019. Romanian visitors mostly used the road and air means of transport for their departures abroad, accounting for 69.1%, respectively for 30.2% of the total departures.

IMPORTANT!

The information in this press release (May 2020) does capture the impact of the COVID-19 crisis and of the measures taken by the authorities as a result of the decree of the state of emergency on March 16, 2020, respectively of the state of alert on May 17, on the Romanian territory.

The National Institute of Statistics understands the difficulties faced by our respondents during this period and we are aware that the answers to the statistical research may not be a priority at present.

However, by collecting statistical information, we will be able to monitor and inform all our users about the effects of COVID-19 on our economy and society.

We appreciate the continued support of our respondents in the statistical research carried out by the National Institute of Statistics and understand the difficulties with which all providers of statistical data are facing.

Additional Information:

The arrival of a tourist in an establishment of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation is registered when a person signs in the register of the respective establishment for one night or several nights' accommodation. In each establishment of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation, regardless of the number of overnight stays, the continuous stay of a tourist counts as one arrival.

The overnight stay means the 24-hours interval, starting with the admission hour of the respective establishment, for which a person signs in the register of the establishment and benefits of accommodation according to the price paid, even if the actual stay lasts less than the mentioned interval.

The net use index of accommodation places represents the relationship between the capacity of tourist accommodation in operation and its actual use by tourists within a determined period. We do the calculation by dividing the total number of overnight stays completed with the tourist accommodation capacity in operation, in the respective period.

The nomenclature of the accommodation structures was established starting from the list of authorized accommodation structures, downloaded from the website of the Ministry of Economy, Energy and Business Environment - Department for Tourism, on February 21, 2020. The list included 14928 structures, of which:

- the apartments and rooms for rent were eliminated, which are the subject of another statistical research (about 3700);
- 4761 units were closed in the survey moment, due to COVID-19, 1670 units were in major repairs at the time of the statistical research and 770 did not complete the questionnaire for other reasons.

Attention! The number of arrivals, respectively overnight stays does not include the quarantined persons, accommodated in the tourist structures.
