The tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception in September 2018

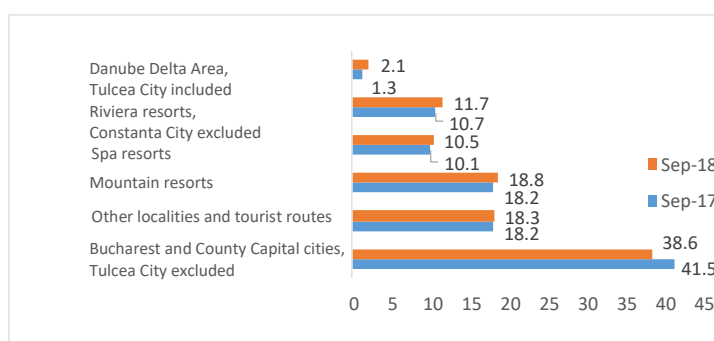
- Compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, the arrivals in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation increased by 9.8 %, while the overnight stays increased by 10.8% in September 2018.
- Compared to September 2017, in September 2018 customs registered an increase in the arrivals of foreign visitors of 7.1 % and an increase of 8.3% in the departures abroad of the Romanian visitors.

1. Arrivals and overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation - September

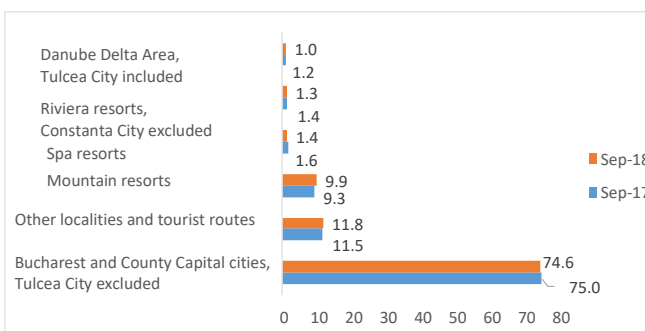

In September 2018, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 1298.4 thousands, 9.8% more compared to September 2017.

In September 2018, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 77.5% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 22.5%, weights similar to those of September 2017.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (74.8% of the total of foreign tourists) and 88.2% of them came from European Union Member States.

In September 2018, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 2981.9 thousands, 10.8% more compared to September 2017.

In September 2018, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 81.7% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 18.3%. As to the overnight stays of foreign citizens in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (73.5% of the total of foreign tourists) and 87.1% of them came from European Union Member States.

In September 2018, **the average duration of stay** was 2.4 days for Romanian tourists and 1.9 days for the foreign tourists.

In September 2018, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 36.9% on total tourists' accommodation structures, increasing by 2.5 percentage points compared to September 2017.

In September 2018, hotels (46.7%), bungalows (30.3%), tourist villas (29.8%), ship accommodation places (26.9%), tourist boarding houses (24.9%) and hostels (24.8%) registered higher use indices of accommodation places.

In September 2018, **the arrivals of foreign visitors in Romania**, according to *customs*, amounted to 1070.3 thousands, 7.1% more compared to September 2017. Most of the foreign visitors came from European countries (91.5%). 47.1% of the total arrivals of the foreign visitors to Romania were from European Union Member States, out of which the most arrivals were from Bulgaria (28.6%), Hungary (23.3%), Germany (9.8%), Italy (7.7%), Poland (5.6%), France (4.1%) and the United Kingdom (4.0%).

In September 2018, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad**, according to *customs*, amounted to 2096.3 thousands, by 8.3% more compared to September 2017. The Romanian visitors abroad mostly used the means of road transport, 66.8% of the total departures.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2018, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 10006.2 thousands, 5.5% more compared to the period 1.01-30.09.2017.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2018, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 77.9% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 22.1%, weights similar to those of the period 1.01-30.09.2017.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (74.6% of the total of foreign tourists) and 85.6% of them came from European Union Member States.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2018, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 22551.0 thousands, 5.0% more compared to the period 1.01-30.09.2017.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2018, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 81.3% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 18.7%. As to the overnight stays of foreign visitors in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (73.2% of the total of foreign tourists) and 84.5% of them came from European Union Member States.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2018, **the average duration of stay** was 2.4 days for Romanian tourists and 1.9 days for foreign tourists.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2018, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 33.3% on total tourists' accommodation structures, 1.1 percentage points more compared to the period 1.01-30.09.2017.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2018, hotels (42.0%), bungalows (31.4%), tourist villas (27.7%), ship accommodation places (25.4%), tourist halts (23.2%), hostels (24.7%) and tourist boarding houses (21.6%) registered higher use indices of accommodation places.

By county, the number of tourists' arrivals in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation*) recorded in the period 1.01 – 30.09.2018 higher values in Bucharest Municipality (1554.0 thousands), Constanța (1248.6 thousands), Brașov (1028.8 thousands) and Cluj (494.1 thousands), while the number of tourists' overnight stays*) recorded higher values in Constanța (4816.1

thousands), Bucharest Municipality (2533.0 thousands), Braşov (2037.9 thousands) and Cluj (922.5 thousands).

Most of the foreign visitors accommodated in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation**) came from Germany (265.1 thousands), Israel (219.9 thousands), Italy (184.1 thousands), France (135.7 thousands) and Hungary (130.9 thousands).

In the period 1.01-30.09.2018, **the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania**, according to *customs*, amounted to 9097.0 thousands, 7.6% more compared to the period 1.01-30.09.2017. Most of the foreign visitors came from European countries (92.3%). 48.7% of the total arrivals of the foreign visitors to Romania were from European Union Member States, out of which the most arrivals were from Bulgaria (27.0%), Hungary (26.0%), Germany (8.7%), Italy (7.8%), Poland (5.7%), France (4.0%) and the United Kingdom (3.8%).

In the period 1.01-30.09.2018, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad**, according to *customs*, amounted to 16776.2 thousands, by 6.6% more compared to the period 1.01-30.09.2017. The Romanian visitors abroad mostly used the means of road transport, 69.5% of the total departures.

Additional Information:

Methodological Note

The arrival of a tourist in an establishment of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation is registered when a person signs in the register of the respective establishment for one night or several nights' accommodation. In each establishment of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation, regardless of the number of overnight stays, the continuous stay of a tourist counts as one arrival.

The overnight stay means the 24-hours interval, starting with the admission hour of the respective establishment, for which a person signs in the register of the establishment and benefits of accommodation according to the price paid, even if the actual stay lasts less than the mentioned interval.

The net use index of accommodation places represents the relationship between the capacity of tourist accommodation in operation and its actual use by tourists within a determined period. We do the calculation by dividing the total number of overnight stays completed with the tourist accommodation capacity in operation, in the respective period.
