The tourism in month of September 2019

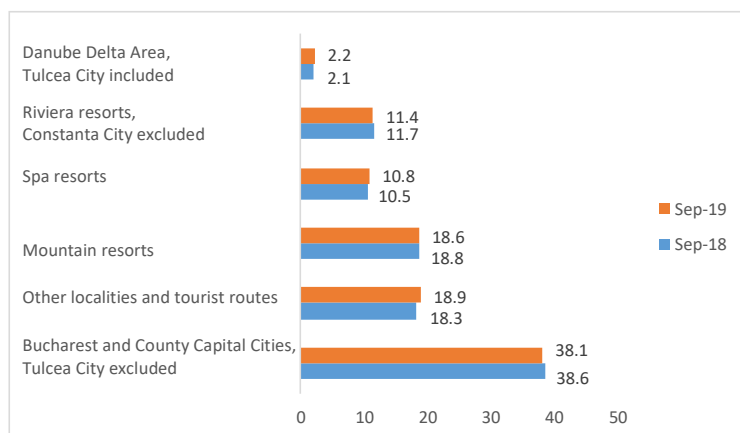
- *Compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, the arrivals in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation increased by 1.1 %, while the overnight stays increased by 1.5% in September 2019.*
- *Compared to September 2018, in September 2019 customs registered an increase in the arrivals of foreign visitors of 10.3 % and an increase of 7.1% in the departures abroad of the Romanian visitors.*

1. Arrivals and overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation - September

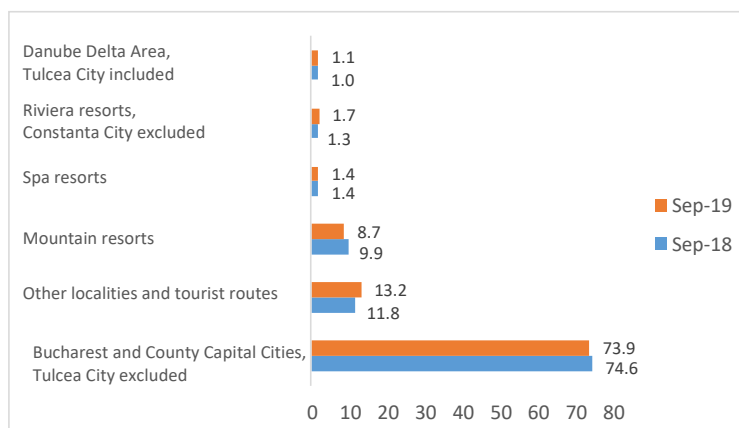

In September 2019, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 1312.5 thousands, 1.1% more compared to September 2018.

In September 2019, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 78.1% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 21.9%.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (75.4% of the total of foreign tourists) and 85.7% of them came from European Union Member States.

In September 2019, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 3027.9 thousands, 1.5% more compared to September 2018.

In September 2019, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 82.3% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 17.7%. As to the overnight stays of foreign citizens in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (73.6% of the total of foreign tourists) and 85.9% of them came from European Union Member States.

In September 2019, **the average duration of stay** was 2.4 days for Romanian tourists and 1.9 days for the foreign tourists.

In September 2019, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 37.7% on total tourists' accommodation structures, increasing by 0.8 percentage points compared to September 2018.

In September 2019, hotels (47.2%), ship accommodation places (41.1%), tourist villas (31.0%), tourist boarding houses (24.4%), hostels (24.0%), bungalows and holiday villages (23.3% each) and agro-tourist boarding houses (23.2%) registered higher use indices of accommodation places.

In September 2019, **the arrivals of foreign visitors in Romania**, according to *customs*, amounted to 1180.3 thousands, 10.3% more compared to September 2018. Road and air transport means were mostly used in case of arrivals from abroad, accounting for 73.9%, respectively for 23.0% of total arrivals.

In September 2019, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad**, according to *customs*, amounted to 2244.8 thousands, by 7.1% more compared to September 2018. The Romanian visitors mostly used the means of road and air transport for their departures abroad, accounting for 66.5%, respectively for 32.9% of total departures.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2019, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 10449.5 thousands, 4.4% more compared to the period 1.01-30.09.2018.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2019, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 79.8% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 20.2%. As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (74.4% of the total of foreign tourists) and 84.9% of them came from European Union Member States.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2019, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 23902.0 thousands, 6.0% more compared to the period 1.01-30.09.2018.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2019, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 82.8% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 17.2%. As to the overnight stays of foreign visitors in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (72.1% of the total of foreign tourists) and 84.3% of them came from European Union Member States.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2019, **the average duration of stay** was 2.4 days for Romanian tourists and 2.0 days for foreign tourists.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2019, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 35.4% on total tourists' accommodation structures, 2.1 percentage points more compared to the period 1.01-30.09.2018.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2019, hotels (44.0%), bungalows (33.2%), tourist villas (29.7%), ship accommodation places (27.9%), hostels (26.4%), camping sites (24.5%) and tourist boarding houses (23.1%) registered higher use indices of accommodation places.

By county, the number of tourists' arrivals in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation*) recorded in the period 1.01 – 30.09.2019 higher values in Bucharest Municipality (1530.7 thousands), Constanța (1309.6 thousands), Brașov (1062.5 thousands), Cluj (509.4

thousands), Mureş (466.8 thousands) and Prahova (445.9 thousands), while the number of tourists' overnight stays^{*)} recorded higher values in Constanţa (4981.8 thousands), Bucharest Municipality (2637.1 thousands), Braşov (2118.9 thousands), Bihor (1186.4 thousands), Vâlcea (1156.9 thousands), Prahova (996.9 thousands), Cluj (955.4 thousands) and Mureş (903.5 thousands).

Most of the foreign visitors accommodated in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation^{**)} came from Germany (239.3 thousands), Israel (180.6 thousands), Italy (170.2 thousands), USA (129.3 thousands), Hungary (128.1 thousands), France (122.7 thousands) and the United Kingdom (108.8%).

In the reference period 1.01-30.09.2019, **the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania**, according to *customs*, amounted to 10023.4 thousands, 10.2% more compared to the period 1.01-30.09.2018. The road and air means of transport were mostly used for the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania, accounting for 75.1%, respectively for 22.4% of total arrivals.

In the period 1.01-30.09.2019, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad**, according to *customs*, amounted to 18446.0 thousands, by 10.0% more compared to the period 1.01-30.09.2018. Romanian visitors mostly used the road and air means of transport for their departures abroad, accounting for 69.7%, respectively for 29.8% of the total departures.

Additional Information:

The arrival of a tourist in an establishment of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation is registered when a person signs in the register of the respective establishment for one night or several nights' accommodation. In each establishment of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation, regardless of the number of overnight stays, the continuous stay of a tourist counts as one arrival.

The overnight stay means the 24-hours interval, starting with the admission hour of the respective establishment, for which a person signs in the register of the establishment and benefits of accommodation according to the price paid, even if the actual stay lasts less than the mentioned interval.

The net use index of accommodation places represents the relationship between the capacity of tourist accommodation in operation and its actual use by tourists within a determined period. We do the calculation by dividing the total number of overnight stays completed with the tourist accommodation capacity in operation, in the respective period.

Data source: the statistical survey on "Occupancy of tourist reception structures with accommodation functions"; this survey addresses all the tourist reception structures with a capacity of at least 10 bed places, operating in the reference month and certified for operation (classified) by the Ministry of Tourism – about 8500 economic operators.
