
The tourism in month of November 2018

- Compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, the arrivals in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation increased by 10.4 %, while the overnight stays increased by 10.8% in November 2018.
- Compared to November 2017, in November 2018 customs registered an increase in the arrivals of foreign visitors of 7.9 % and a decrease of 1.2% in the departures abroad of the Romanian visitors.


1. The distribution of Romanian tourists' arrivals in the establishments of tourists' reception, by tourist areas, in November 2018 compared to November 2017

In November 2018, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 917.7 thousands, 10.4% more compared to November 2017.

In November 2018, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 80.5% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 19.5%, weights similar to those of November 2017.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (74.5% of the total of foreign tourists) and 82.3% of them came from European Union Member States.

In November 2018, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 1959.8 thousands, 10.8% more compared to November 2017.

In November 2018, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 82.4% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 17.6%. As to the overnight stays of foreign citizens in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (73.8% of the total of foreign tourists) and 81.7% of them came from European Union Member States.

In November 2018, the average duration of stay was 2.2 days for Romanian tourists and 1.9 days for the foreign tourists.

In November 2018, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 30.0% on total tourists' accommodation structures, increasing by 2.3 percentage points compared to November 2017.

In November 2018, hotels (39.8%), hostels (20.4%), tourist villas (18.9%), tourist boarding houses (18.7%), motels (15.2%) and agro-touristic boarding houses (14.5%) registered higher use indices of accommodation places.

In November 2018, the arrivals of foreign visitors in Romania, according to *customs*, amounted to 815.5 thousands, 7.9% more compared to November 2017. Most of the foreign visitors came from European countries (93.3%). 50.6% of the total arrivals of the foreign visitors to Romania were from European Union Member States, out of which the most arrivals were from Bulgaria (32.1%), Hungary (24.7%), Italy (9.4%), Germany (6.8%), Poland (4.9%), France (3.5%) and the United Kingdom (3.2%).

In November 2018, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad,** according to *customs*, amounted to 1396.1 thousands, by 1.2% less compared to November 2017. The Romanian visitors abroad mostly used the means of road transport, 64.2% of the total departures.

In the period 1.01-30.11.2018, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 11993.1 thousands, 6.4% more compared to the period 1.01-30.11.2017.

In the period 1.01-30.11.2018, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 78.0% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 22.0%, weights similar to those of the period 1.01-30.11.2017.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (74.6% of the total of foreign tourists) and 85.7% of them came from European Union Member States.

In the period 1.01-30.11.2018, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted to 26808.1 thousands, 5.9% more compared to the period 1.01-30.11.2017.

In the period 1.01-30.11.2018, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 81.3% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 18.7%. As to the overnight stays of foreign visitors in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (73.2% of the total of foreign tourists) and 84.3% of them came from European Union Member States.

In the period 1.01-30.11.2018, **the average duration of stay** was 2.3 days for Romanian tourists and 1.9 days for foreign tourists.

In the period 1.01-30.11.2018, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 33.1% on total tourists' accommodation structures, 1.4 percentage points more compared to the period 1.01-30.11.2017.

In the period 1.01-30.11.2018, hotels (42.0%), bungalows (29.2%), tourist villas (26.6%), hostels (24.2%), ship accommodation places (23.3%), tourist halts (21.9%) and tourist boarding houses (21.3%) registered higher use indices of accommodation places.

By county, the number of tourists' arrivals in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation*) recorded in the period 1.01 – 30.11.2018 higher values in Bucharest Municipality (1933.8 thousands), Constanţa (1294.6 thousands), Braşov (1250.5 thousands) and Cluj (612.1 thousands), while the number of tourists' overnight stays*) recorded higher values in Constanţa (4963.8 thousands), Bucharest Municipality (3150.3 thousands), Braşov (2439.6 thousands) and Cluj (1140.7 thousands).

Most of the foreign visitors accommodated in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation**) came from Germany (311.9 thousands), Israel (255.0 thousands), Italy (224.7 thousands), France (161.7 thousands) and the USA (157.4 thousands).

In the period 1.01-30.11.2018, **the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania**, according to *customs*, amounted to 10874.3 thousands, 7.5% more compared to the period 1.01-30.11.2017. Most of the foreign visitors came from European countries (92.3%). 49.0% of the total arrivals of the foreign visitors to Romania were from European Union Member States, out of which the most arrivals were from Bulgaria (27.5%), Hungary (25.8%), Germany (8.5%), Italy (8.0%), Poland (5.6%), France (4.0%) and the United Kingdom (3.8%).

In the period 1.01-30.11.2018, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad,** according to *customs*, amounted to 19730.0 thousands, by 5.7% more compared to the period 1.01-30.11.2017. The Romanian visitors abroad mostly used the means of road transport, 68.5% of the total departures.

Note: The arrivals of foreign visitors and the departures of Romanian visitors were rectified as against those previously published.

Additional Information:

Methodological Note

The arrival of a tourist in an establishment of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation is registered when a person signs in the register of the respective establishment for one night or several nights' accommodation. In each establishment of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation, regardless of the number of overnight stays, the continuous stay of a tourist counts as one arrival.

The overnight stay means the 24-hours interval, starting with the admission hour of the respective establishment, for which a person signs in the register of the establishment and benefits of accommodation according to the price paid, even if the actual stay lasts less than the mentioned interval.

The net use index of accommodation places represents the relationship between the capacity of tourist accommodation in operation and its actual use by tourists within a determined period. We do the calculation by dividing the total number of overnight stays completed with the tourist accommodation capacity in operation, in the respective period.
