
In 2016, the tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception increased by 7.8% compared to 2015

- Compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, both the arrivals and the overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation increased by 8.2% and by 7.0%, respectively, in December 2016.
- Compared to December 2015, in December 2016, customs registered an increase in both the arrivals of foreign visitors of 3.4% and in the departures abroad of the Romanian visitors of 5.6%.



In December 2016, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted 709.4 thousand, 8.2% more compared to December 2015.

In December 2016, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 79.9% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 20.1%, weights similar to those of December 2015.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (72.5% of the total of foreign tourists) and 83.5% of them came from European Union Member States.

In December 2016, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted 1426.2 thousand, 7.0% more compared to December 2015.

In December 2016, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 80.5% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 19.5%. As to the overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (72.7% of the total of foreign tourists) and 83.8% of them came from European Union Member States.

In December 2016, the average time of stay was 2.0 days for both the Romanian and foreign tourists.

In December 2016, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 23.0% on total tourists' accommodation, 1.2 pp more compared to December 2015.

In December 2016, hotels (27.8%), tourist villas (19.4%), tourist boarding houses (18.3%), hostels (16.0%) and agro-tourist boarding houses (15.5%) registered higher indices of accommodation places.

In December 2016, the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania, according to *customs*, amounted 736.7 thousand, 3.4% more compared to December 2015. Most of the foreign visitors came from European countries (93.3%). 53.7% of the total arrivals of the foreign visitors to Romania were from European Union Member States, out of which the most arrivals were from Bulgaria (31.1%), Hungary (27.4%), Italy (9.4%), Germany (7.3%), Poland and France (3.6 % each) .

In December 2016, the departures of Romanian visitors abroad, according to *customs*, amounted 1112.3 thousand, 5.6% more compared to December 2015 The Romanian visitors abroad mostly used the means of road transport, 67.0% of the total departures.

In 2016, **the arrivals** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted 10917.4 thousand, 10.4% more compared to 2015.

In 2016, the arrivals of the Romanian tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 77.4% of the total arrivals, while the foreign tourists were 22.6%, weights similar to those of 2015.

As to the arrivals of the foreign tourists in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (74.8% of the total of foreign tourists) and 85.4% of them came from European Union Member States.

In 2016, **the overnight stays** in the establishments of tourists' reception amounted 25275.0 thousand, 7.8 % more compared to 2015.

In 2016, the Romanian tourists' overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception with functions of tourists' accommodation were 81.0% of the total overnight stays, while the foreign tourists' overnight stays were 19.0%. As to the overnight stays in the establishments of tourists' reception, the highest weight had those coming from Europe (73.3% of the total of foreign tourists) and 83.8% of them came from European Union Member States.

In 2016, the average time of stay was 2.4 days for the Romanian tourists and 1.9 days for the foreign tourists.

In 2016, **the net use index** of accommodation places was 30.8% on total tourists' accommodation, 2.0 pp more compared to 2015.

In 2016, hotels (38.9%), ship accommodation places (26.1%), tourist villas (24.1%) and bungalows (22.7%) registered higher indices of accommodation places.

The most arrivals of foreign tourists accommodated in the establishments of tourists' reception*) were from Germany (281.7 thousand), Israel (251.9 thousand), Italy (233.8 thousand), France (145.6 thousand) and Great Britain (140.6 thousand).

In 2016, the arrivals of foreign visitors to Romania, according to *customs*, amounted 10222.9 thousand, 9.6% more compared to 2015. Most of the foreign visitors came from European countries (93.0%). 54.0% of the total arrivals of the foreign visitors to Romania were from European Union Member States, out of which the most arrivals were from Hungary (28.3%), Bulgaria (27.6%), Germany (8.4%), Italy (7.7%), Poland (5.5%) and France (3.6%).

In 2016, **the departures of Romanian visitors abroad,** according to *customs*, amounted 16128.0 thousand, 22.9% more compared to 2015. The Romanian visitors abroad mostly used the means of road transport, 68.8% of the total departures.
