The agricultural production value by development regions, in 2022 - final data -

- In 2022, the agricultural production value was 109567.7 mill. lei in current prices.
- In 2022, also, the crop production holds the highest share (65.6%) in the structure of the agricultural production value, decreasing compared to the previous year by 5.6 p.p.

In 2022, compared to 2021, the crop production registered increases solely in the South-Muntenia (+0.3 percentage points) development region; decreases were registered in the other development regions: South-East (-39.0 percentage points), North-East (-34.0 percentage points), Bucharest-Ilfov (-30.4 percentage points), North-West (-25.4 percentage points), West (-22.8 percentage points), South West-Oltenia (-21.0 percentage points) and in the Centre (-18.9 percentage points).

The animal production, in 2022 compared to 2021, registered increases in the West (+3.5 percentage points), North-West (+3.1 percentage points), South-Muntenia (+1.5 percentage points) and in the Centre (+0.3 percentage points) development regions; in all the other development regions, the animal production registered decreases between 7.4 and 2.7 percentage points.

The agricultural services value increased in all the development regions, between 46.3 and 8.8 percentage points.

Share of crop and animal production value in agricultural production value, per total and by development regions, in 2022



The crop production holds the highest share in the agricultural production in all development regions of the country, with values between 57.2% (in the North-Est and Centre development regions) and 77.0% in the South-Muntenia¹ development region.

¹ The Bucharest-Ilfov development region is not included in the analysis, being insignificant in terms of the share in the agricultural production value at national level.

Structure of the agricultural production value by development regions



In 2022 compared to 2021, the structure of the agricultural production value registered the highest increases in the South-Muntenia (+3.3 percentage points) and in the West (+0.4 percentage points) development regions. The most important decreases were registered in the South-East (-2.9 percentage points), North-West (-1.3 percentage points) development regions.

In the structure of crop production in 2022, the highest shares belong to the following development regions: South-Muntenia (26.0%), South-East (16.5%) and South-West Oltenia (13.8%), while in the structure of animal production of the same year, the highest shares are held by the development regions: North-East (20.1%), North-West (15.4%), South-Muntenia (14.9%) and Centre (14.7%).

The development regions include the following counties:

- North-East development region: Bacau, Botosani, Iasi, Neamt, Suceava and Vaslui.
- South-East development region: Braila, Buzau, Constanta, Galati, Tulcea and Vrancea.
- South-Muntenia development region: Arges, Calarasi, Dambovita, Giurgiu, Ialomita, Prahova and Teleorman.
- South-West Oltenia development region: Dolj, Gorj, Mehedinti, Olt and Valcea.
- West development region: Arad, Caras-Severin, Hunedoara and Timis.
- North-West development region: Bihor, Bistrita-Nasaud, Cluj, Maramures, Satu-Mare and Salaj.
- Centre development region: Alba, Brasov, Covasna, Harghita, Mures and Sibiu.
- Bucharest-Ilfov development region: Bucharest municipality and Ilfov county.
