# **VOLUME OF REMOVED WOOD IN 2015**

In 2015 the volume of removed wood by economic operators with logging activity was by 1.2% lower than in 2014.

- The volume of round wood decreased by 0.1% in 2015 compared to 2014
- Log processing in timber was the main destination of round wood



Out of round wood volume, 39.3% represents coniferous and 60.7% broadleaf species. Among broadleaf species, beech wood has the highest share, accounting for 33.6% of total round wood.


#### Distribution of the volume of roundwood timber species

In 2015 compared to 2014, a fall by 0.1% was registered in the volume of round wood mainly because of the decrease in the volume of removed wood.

#### Volume of round wood in 2015 compared to 2014



Log processing in timber was the main destination of round wood removed, at a rate of 56.4%, 2.0 percentage points less than in 2014, followed by fuel wood at rate of 33.2%, 1.5 percentage points more than the previous year.
