### Volume of wood removed in 2017

- In 2017, the economic operators certified for logging reported a volume of wood removed by 3.1% lower than in 2016.
- Compared to 2016, a decrease by 2.8% of removed round wood volume was recorded in 2017.
- The same year, log processing in timber was the main destination of removed round wood.

In the total round wood volume, broadleaf species hold the highest share (63.9%), while coniferous species account for 36.1%.

Among broadleaf species, beech wood has the highest share, accounting for 33.7% of total round wood.

# Distribution of the volume of roundwood timber species



In 2017, compared to 2016, a decrease by 2.8% in the volume of round wood was recorded, mainly due to the decrease in the removed wood volume.



Log processing in timber was the main destination of round wood removed, with a share of 53.4 %, 1.5 percentage points less compared to 2016, followed by fuel wood with a share of 34.8%, 0.6 percentage points more as against previous year.
