Volume of wood removed in 2018

- In 2018, the economic operators certified for logging reported a volume of wood removed by 8.9% bigger than in 2017.
- Compared to 2017, an increase by 8.8% of removed round wood volume was recorded in 2018.

In the total round wood volume, broadleaf species hold the highest share (62.8%), while coniferous species account for 37.2%.

Among broadleaf species, beech wood has the highest share accounting for 34.0% of total round wood.

Distribution of the volume of roundwood timber species in 2018



In 2018 compared to 2017 an increase by 8.8% in the volume of round wood was recorded, mainly due:

- softwood species that had an increase of 12.2% with a weight of 37.2% in the volume of round wood exploited
- hardwood species, of which beech and oak, which together recorded an increase of 11.2%, with a weight of 44.2% in the volume of round wood exploited.

Volume of wood in 2018 compared with 2017



Log processing in timber was the main destination of round wood removed, with a share of 52.8 %, followed by fuel wood with a share of 34.7%.
